Please visit <http://www.auburn.edu/activate> to activate your AU Access account. Once your account has been activated, you will have access to TigerMail, your Auburn e-mail account, and tigeri, Auburn's student web portal. If your address or e-mail information has changed since you applied, please send an e-mail containing your reference number and the updated information to gradadm@auburn.edu.


I strongly recommend that you contact Dr. D. Allen Davis, your advisor, prior to registering and for answers to any questions you might have about your graduate career at Auburn. The e-mail address is davisda@auburn.edu. According to university policy, no new student can register for courses until a completed Medical Information Form (<https://ews.auburn.edu/aumc/Students.aspx>) is on file at the Auburn University Medical Clinic. Departments may require distance education students to satisfy these medical requirements. Students pursuing distance education graduate degrees (unless required by the department) are exempt from these medical requirements. International students will be enrolled and billed for mandatory international student health insurance upon arrival. Domestic students with assistantships are automatically billed and enrolled in the insurance program. Please go to grad.auburn.edu/insurance.

Early in your graduate career you will need to identify a major professor and committee to supervise your program at Auburn.
